STUDENT DRESS CODE

1. **KHAKI, Black, or NAVY BLUE pants, shorts, shirts, skirts, capris, or jumpers/dresses.**
2. **Shorts, skirts, and jumpers/dresses must be NO MORE THAN TWO INCHES ABOVE THE KNEE (measured at the hem length).**
3. **A solid color RED, WHITE, BLACK, or NAVY BLUE COLLARED SHIRT. LONG SLEEVED. TURTLENECK SHIRTS in RED, WHITE, Black, or NAVY BLUE can be substituted in the winter.**
4. **Undershirts must be RED, WHITE, BLACK, or NAVY BLUE.**
5. **NO LOGOS ON ANY SHIRTS. NO WORDING OR PICTURES. "NO EXCEPTIONS."**
6. **Clothing must be appropriately sized.**
7. **Sweaters are allowed. No shirts worn as jackets. No cut ties on shirts or pants.**
8. **All shirts, tops, and dresses must have sleeves that cover the shoulders and be worn in the manner intended by the manufacturer.**
9. **Torn, ripped, frayed, patched, or un-hemmed clothing.**
10. **Stretch pants and exercise pants are not permitted.**
11. **All trousers, pants, or shorts must totally cover undergarments, including boxer shorts.**
12. **Pants must be secured at the waist with a BELT. All pants must have belt loops. Pants cannot be "sagging" or tucked in boots. Pants cannot be rolled at the ends.**
13. **All shirttails (girls and boys) must be tucked into pants at all times: before, during, and after school.**
14. **No suspenders of any color.**
15. **Head coverings, picks, combs, curlers, suggestive designs and cuts in the hair are not permitted.**
16. **No accessories will be worn other than a watch. Male students are not permitted to wear earrings. No body piercings other than earrings for females.**
17. **A solid color RED, WHITE, OR NAVY BLUE FLEECE sweat shirt or sweater may be worn. No vests may be worn over uniform shirts.**
18. **Hats are prohibited.**
19. **Only prescription lenses are allowed at school.**
20. **Hair accessories for girls only. No scarves tied round head. Headbands must not exceed two inches in width and can be worn on the forehead. Headbands are not to be worn around the neck.**
21. **Bright colored hair (Pink, Orange, Yellow, Red, Blue, Purple, Green, White, etc.). Maroon, burgundy, and brown hair must be blended with the student's black hair.**

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22. Safe and appropriate footwear must be worn. Slippers, flip-flops, sandals, or bedroom shoes are in violation of CCMS dress code.

23. Shoes must be tied and velcro straps strapped.

24. Camouflage is not permitted.

25. Students must wear solid colored jackets. No pictures (skulls, bones, weapons, etc.) on jackets/outer wear. In an effort to assess the dress code, all coats must be unzipped in the buildings.

26. Book bags must be placed in lockers during the school day. Students can only have book bags when they are transitioning to the gymnasium for physical education.

27. Grooming w/combs and brushes during the school day is unacceptable. All combs and brushes must be put away (locker or purse).

28. Students who transfer from other schools and/or districts will be given five (5) school days to comply with the CCMS dress code.

****Any other dress code discrepancies will be addressed by the principal.**

Parents and students are expected to honor the dress code so that valuable school time is not spent examining student's attire to determine appropriateness. Students who violate the dress code will call home for an appropriate change in clothing and sign the dress code notebook. If a parent is not available, the student will not be allowed to return to class but will instead be supervised in the in-school suspension area. Parents and students will be notified of any exceptions to the dress code. The principal will exercise individual discretion in assigning corrective measures to ensure dress code conformity.
