

DRESS CODE

We appreciate parent and student compliance with the dress code. Parents may be contacted by letter or phone for dress code violations.

Notes:

- The administrators' discretion applies to the appropriateness of **all** clothing.
- The uniform/dress code policy will be strictly enforced throughout the school year.
- Uniform-free days will be announced and notification will be sent home to parents.

GUIDELINES OF UNIFORM DRESS CODE

Bottoms

- Navy, Black or khaki slacks, shorts, skirts, skorts, or jumpers
- Cargo pants or any other style of pants with additional large pockets on the front, back or sides of pant leg are **PERMITTED**.
- No colored jeans are permitted.
- Bottoms should **NOT** contain any designs or patterns such as, but not limited to, embroidery and embellishments such as, sequins or rhinestones, glitter, stripes, or strings/tassels. **ONLY SOLID COLORS ARE ACCEPTABLE.**

Tops

- Navy, red, white, royal blue, or khaki polo-style shirts with collar; **sky-blue or baby blue tops are not to be worn.**
- Round-collar (peter pan) blouses are acceptable for girls.
- Only **SOLID COLOR** tops are to be worn.
- Tops should not contain any designs or patterns such as, but not limited to, emblems, logos, embroidery, sequins or rhinestones, stripes, colored-trim on collar and/or sleeves, glitter, or strings/tassels
- Polo-style tennis dresses and jumpers are permitted only in **SOLID** navy, red, and khaki.
- T-shirts are not classified as uniform shirts even if they are one of the above colors. T-shirts are only to be worn underneath uniform tops.
- **NO** vests of any type are to be worn.

Shoes

- Flip-flops, sandals, bedroom shoes, or thong-toe shoes are **NOT** permitted without a documented medical request.
- Sandals and high heels should **NOT** be worn to prevent possible foot injuries.
- Boots or tennis shoes that lace-up to the knee are **NOT** permitted.

Jewelry

- *No chains or long necklaces; no long beaded necklaces should be worn.*
- *No large, long, flashy and distractive earrings should be worn.*
- *No rubber band jewelry should be worn.*
- *No bracelets or bangles should be worn.*

Other Provisions

- *Shirts and blouses are to be worn inside of pants or skirts at all times.*
- *Boys are expected to wear a belt daily. Pants are **NOT** to be worn sagging;*
- *Noncompliance is subject to disciplinary action.*
- *Neither decorative/designed nor electronic belt buckles should be worn. This includes extremely large belt buckles as well.*
- *Shorts, skirt, and jumper length should be adequate and appropriate. Inappropriate length will be determined according to size and height on an individual basis. *Applies on uniform-free days as well*
- *Clothing should **NOT** be extremely tight in fit. * This applies on uniform-free days as well.*
- *T-shirts worn underneath uniform shirts and are visible **MUST** be one of the approved uniform colors. Shirts worn underneath uniform shirts cannot be multi-colored or any color that is **NOT** a uniform color. For example, a student may wear a red uniform polo shirt with a navy t-shirt underneath, long-sleeved or short-sleeved, but it may not be orange.*
- ***NO** leggings of any type may be worn underneath skirts, skorts, or jumpers.*
- *Tights may be worn as long as they are white, red, or navy.*
- *Uniform-free days: Bareback, spaghetti straps, tank tops, short-shorts, and “cut-offs” are inappropriate dress choices and are not permitted.*
- *Clothing, jewelry and any accessories that depict inappropriate or suggestive wording are **forbidden**. This includes but is not limited to clothing that advertises or promotes drugs, alcohol, tobacco, gangs, gangsters, or violence.*
- *Gloves are **NOT** permitted during the school day.*
- *Bowties are **NOT** permitted.*
- *Eyeglasses are **NOT** permitted without a documented medical prescription.*
- *Purses may **NOT** be carried around the school.*
- *Large overcoats or jackets may **NOT** be worn during instructional time.*
- *Pullovers/Hoodies may **NOT** be worn during instructional time.*

Haircuts/Styles

- *Any haircut/style that interferes with the learning environment shall **NOT** be permitted.*
- *Haircuts with parts and designs are permitted; however, they must **NOT** be exaggerated or extreme.*
- *Mohawks are permitted; however, they must **NOT** be exaggerated or extreme. If the student is to return to school, the design or wordings must no longer be visible, i.e., a new haircut resolves the problem.*

Dress Code Consequences

- *Students will be placed in ISS until parent picks the child up.*
- *Repeat offenders may incur more severe discipline consequences.*
