### Age Requirements:

- Head Start- Child must be 3 years old by September 1st
- Early Head Start- Child must be 6 weeks to 3 years old

### Required Documents:

- Proof of Child's Age (child's birth certificate or confirmation of birth)
- Proof of Family Income (2020 W2 or Tax return, or 2 current check stubs, or a public assistance letter, or WG-15 form)
- Disability Diagnosis Documentation if your child has a disability (IEP, IFSP or Medical Documents)
